In supersession of this Department's Notification of even No. dt.23/2/2016 and in exercise of the powers vested under Rule 28 of the Mizoram Minor Minerals Concession Rules, 2000 the Government of Mizoram is pleased to amend the rates of royalty in the second Schedule of the Mizoram Minor Minerals Concession Rules, 2000 as below with effect from the date of publication in the Official Gazette and until further order:-
