B. ESTABLISHMENT

During 2023 – 2024, one (1) post of Geologist and one (1) post of Assistant Controller of Mines were filled up and both have joined the office. Also, the recruitment of four (4) posts of Junior Technical Assistant was conducted. However, final result is yet to be published. Two (2) staff; one JTA and the other, IV- Grade were regularized.

With the superannuation of Pu Lalthazuala, Pu R. Zirtluanga was promoted to the Director while Pu Lianngura Pachuau also got promoted to Joint Director. One (1) Finance & Accounts Officer (FAO) was also posted in the office.

C. MINOR MINERAL INVESTIGATION, DEVELOPMENT AND ADMINISTRATION

The revenue generated from minor minerals during 2023 – 2024 has accrued to Rs. 11,25,69,183/- which is the highest ever achieved by the Department since the inception of the Department.
